### IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION • ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES

Preliminary confirmation to be read, and corrections emailed to the Trial Secretary before the trial closes. Final confirmations to be emailed after the closing date. If you do not hear from the Trial Secretary that means they did not get your entry. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Trial Secretary either by email, mail, or phone to be sure of the status of your entry before any deadline dates passes. **The trial secretary is not responsible for entries not received on time, not received at all.**

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**ENTRY FEE: \$29.00 (includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service fee & \$.50 AKC Recording Fee) for the first entry of a dog and \$26.00 for each additional entry of the same dog, same trial. Rally is not used as a second entry in combination with Obedience.**

**OPEN DATE: ENTRIES OPEN February 1, 2023 at 12 noon.**

**CLOSING DATE** for entries **10:00 PM, Wednesday, March 29, 2023**, a wait list will be started when the numerical limit has been reached, if reached before **Wednesday, March 29, 2023** (at Trial Secretary office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. A Wait List to be established if limits are reached before closing date. AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. HOLKC will add a \$45.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. Telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Trial Secretary will make every effort to decipher illegible handwriting but is not responsible for errors due to illegible writing.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made after closing date.

**BITCHES IN SEASON.** Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience Trials, all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, will be refunded. To be eligible for such refund the Trial Secretary must be notified in writing ½ hour or earlier prior to start of first class of the trial together with a veterinarian's certificate on their letterhead confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.** All dogs should arrive 15 minutes before judging time. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs will be judged in catalog order. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when requested.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability, in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

THE OBEDIENCE TRIAL AND RALLY TRIAL will be open from 7:30 A.M. to ½ hour after trial ends.

**DECLINATION OF ENTRIES/REMOVAL OF DOG:** The trial committee may refuse to admit or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the trial-giving club or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate except when being judged.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

**From Minnesota:** From either north or south take the Highway 2 (Bong Memorial Bridge) exit 253A and head east into Superior, Wisconsin. Go through the roundabout to Tower Avenue (2<sup>nd</sup> set of lights) and take a right onto Tower. Head south past Walmart and Menards and get into left lane by this point. Take a left at 46th on the north end of the fairgrounds and go to the fourth entrance as shown in the map below and turn right into the fairgrounds and proceed straight until you get to the 4H building.

**From Wisconsin (coming up Wisconsin 53 or across Highway 2):** Highway 53 merges with Highway 2 about 11 miles south/east of Superior. Continue into Superior heading north. After the lights at 18th street get into the left lane and continue north until you reach Belknap Street/Highway 2 (Bong Museum and Barkers Island will be on your right). Turn left on Belknap and stay in the left lane. Continue heading east until you get to Tower Avenue. Take a left onto Tower Avenue and stay in the left lane. Head south past Walmart and Menards until you reach 46th Street (north end of the fairgrounds) and take a left onto 46th and go to the fourth entrance as shown in the map below and turn right into the fairgrounds and proceed straight until you get to the 4H building.

**From Wisconsin (coming up Wisconsin 35):**

As you enter the city you will pass through the Village of Superior on 35 first. Then after an opening you will see the fairgrounds on your right. 35 is the same as Tower Avenue here. Turn right on 46th street on the north end of the fairgrounds and go to the fourth entrance as shown in the map below and turn right into the fairgrounds and proceed straight until you get to the 4H building.
